first position: both hands parallel to the wall; you see the palms of the hands. forearms point upward

now: Rotation, the forearm does not travel, but stays in place.

end position: both hands parallel to the wall; you see the back of the hands. forearms point upward

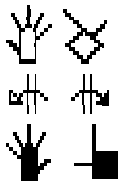
Question: How to spell? Which arrow would be more appropriate?

I think both spellings describe the same movement.

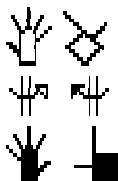
Is that correct?
