Clifton F. Carbin became deaf from meningitis, a common etiology of deafness, at age four. He attended a residential school for the deaf students (Sir James Whitney School, formerly the Ontario School for the Deaf in Belleville), ^{received BA} Gallaudet College ~~(BA)~~ in Washington, D.C. and ^{Master's in Education} Western Maryland College ~~(M.Ed.)~~ in Westminster, Maryland. 50

After teaching at Alberta College in Edmonton, Clifton moved to Vancouver in British Columbia to direct the ^{TOTAL COMM.} ~~Counseling and Home Training Program for Deaf Children and their families~~*, in 1975. His six years 45 old deaf daughter attends Jericho Hill School for the Deaf in Vancouver.

Past positions include President of the Canadian Association of the Deaf (two terms), Editor of the Deaf Canadian magazine, Secretary of the Canadian Coordinating Council on Deafness and a board member of the Western Institute for the Deaf. ^{same par.}

In 1981 Clifton coauthored an international publication entitled Can't Your Child Hear?, a Guide for Those Who Care about Deaf Children. 21

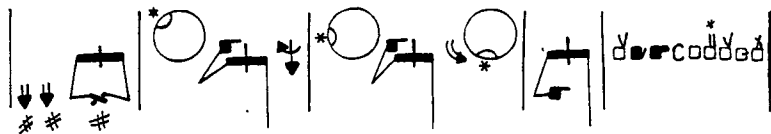
