Use at end of a complete thought or sentence (similar to a period).

Full stop

Pause

Use in the middle of a related thought or sentence (similar to a comma).



Fast or energetically Use at the end of a complete thought or sentence (similar to an exclamation point).



NOT USED because question faces indicate a question.


























When I was five, I went to school.
